





Nicki has won a lot of awards. She has won the BET Best Female Hip-hop Artist, Best New Artist, Best Group, People's Champ, Rookie of the Year, and Made you Look awards. She also won Best Video in the UK Asian Music Awards and NARM Breakthrough Artist of the Year. ❖

the lines of, "Well, hello there!" but which can also be interpreted as "Hello, Domo!"


Domo, the main character, is described as a strange creature that hatched from an egg, with a large, mouth that is locked wide open. His teeth are squiggly.

The RAP teachers that went were Ms. Maggie, Ms. Goreti, Ms. Susana and Mr. Jerome.


The most fun part for me was when we went to perform our cheer.
