Along the way, he actually makes a friend, named Jeanne Galleta, and he actually likes her. She tutors Rafe and tries to tell him why studying is important


Now, if you really want to find out more about the other characters in the series, keep reading.

The New England Patriots used to be the Boston Patriots in the American Football

League (AFL), but then switched its name to the New England Patriots when the team moved to Foxborough in 1971. Foxborough is a suburb only 22 miles away from downtown Boston.

The Patriots were part of the AFL, but when the AFL merged with the NFL, the team became a member of the East division of the American Football Conference (AFC) of the NFL.

Time Since Created

The Patriots were established in 1959, which was about 56 years ago. The Patriots were relocated in 1971. The time Patriots were part of Boston was from 1960 to 1969. The Patriots, which are now in New England, have been there since 1970.


The Patriots started becoming a very successful team in 2000 when Bill Belichick became the head coach of the Patriots.

- ⇒ The most world series titles by any team is 27, that record is held by the New York Yankees.
- ⇒ The National Baseball Hall Of Fame And Museum was created in 1935 to celebrate baseballs 100th anniversary. The Hall Of Fame is located in Cooperstown, NY.
- ⇒ Barry Bonds holds the Major League Baseball home run record with 762. He passed Hank Aaron, who is currently second with 755, on August 7, 2007. The only other player to have hit 700 or more is Babe Ruth with 714.
- ⇒ Baltimore Orioles shortstop Cal Ripken, Jr. didn't miss a game in 16 years. He played in 2,632 consecutive games from April 30, 1982 to Sept. 19, 1998.
- ⇒ Pete Rose, who played for the Cincinnati Reds and then was banned from baseball for life for betting on games while managing the team, holds the all-time record for hits (4,256) and games played (3,562).
- ⇒ Sixteen players have hit four home runs in one game: Bobby Lowe, Ed Delahanty, Lou Gehrig, Chuck Klein, Pat Seerey, Gil Hodges, Joe Adcock, Rocky Colavito, Willie Mays, Mike Schmidt, Bob Horner, Mark Whiten, Mike Cameron, Shawn Green, Carlos Delgado, and Josh Hamilton.

Once, Thomas saw that the maze was about to close on two men, so he squeezed himself through the door to try to save the two men. There was one problem: they were all now trapped inside


of the maze. Thomas didn't give up, even when he saw one man get devoured, and if the man that the monster didn't bite told him that they were already "dead."

A whale is a very kind beast, even though they are around 30 to 100 feet long and can weigh 25 tons!


One species is the Humpback Whale. It can launch itself really high into the air. It is 39-52 feet long and an adult humpback whale weighs 79,000 pounds.
