## Healthy Teeth

USC and PressFriends held a Global Health Symposium for Kids at the USC Health Sciences campus. Students in the Masters program in Global Health at USC gave presentations to PressFriends reporters on a lot of different topics.

One of the topics was Oral Health. Students learned that you have to brush your teeth for 20 seconds. If you sing the "Happy Birthday" song out loud or in your head while you are brushing your teeth, you'll have brushed them about 20 seconds. When you brush your teeth, you should go in all places possible that are on your teeth.

After you finish brushing your teeth, you should floss for a while. Flossing is to help clean those parts of your teeth that the brush didn't reach – such as in between your teeth. Brushing your teeth will help keep them healthy and will keep you from losing your teeth.



They sold two million copies by January of 2015. Ida's goal is to exit the tower. Ida goes through at least 3 levels. The best chapter is The Thief.


